

## Spring Lake School Wide Behavior Plan

Spring Lake will use a ticket system this year in order to maintain school wide behavior and safety. Each ticket issued will include, among other things, the student's name, the behavior and who reported the behavior. A copy of the ticket will be sent home that day and will need to be signed by a parent or guardian and returned to the classroom teacher the following morning before school. Students begin each term with a "clean slate." **An attempt to contact parents will be made by school personnel whenever a ticket is given out.**

### MINOR OFFENSES

- Name calling
- Riding bikes, scooters, rip sticks, roller blades on school grounds
- Teasing
- Using electronic devices during school hours
- Disrespectful attitudes/ behaviors
- Throwing or kicking snow/ice
- Making fun, mocking
- Any others determined by faculty & administration
- Swearing
- Play fighting, horse-playing, kicking, pushing
- Spreading rumors
- Inappropriate notes

\*Recess will be missed until ticket is signed and returned

### MAJOR OFFENSES

- Fighting
- Harassment (major)
- Aggressive behavior inappropriate for school
- Destroying or damaging property (vandalism)
- Intention to harm/hurt
- Any others determined by faculty & administration
- Bullying
- Stealing

<b>MAJOR OFFENSES</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> Offense	2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense	3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense
<b>Consequences</b>	Ticket & Home Suspension **1 day**	Ticket & Home Suspension **2-3 days**	Ticket & Home Suspension **3-5 days**

There will be an activity at the end of each term for all students who receive 1 or less tickets in that term.
