**Data:**

- Final result from last year, goal was to have growth in bench mark levels
- Itemized budgeted expenditure list – compare to growth
- Sage results – how did expenditures measure actual test scores
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade group didn't show growth
  - Other grades DID show growth
  - 100% kids showed improvement in reading levels.

**2017-18 Plan:**

1. 2% improvement in grade level performance, (DIBELS) Reading tutors need programmatic books
  2. 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade will show science growth at end of unit science assembly
- Grant written over the summer by Teresa Jordan for Technology specialist
    - Purpose is to push technology with the teachers in science and math
    - District gave 48 chrome books – divided them between the younger grade levels
  - Myon vs. Raz-kids – there is some wiggle room

**Brainstorm use of funds:**

- Staff development @ adolescent literacy
- Science
  - Stem fest not worth it this year
  - Grade level sharing science kits
  - Subscriptions to science – software/brain pop
  - Teacher feedback at next meeting
- Does council feel we should make an addendum? YES
  - Professional technical training/services if the traveling fund wasn't used last year, move funds
- District will adopt science next year, a guaranteed viable curriculum
- Internet safety – Net smarts, computer safety – can add to school improvement plan
