(Spectators can park in the Parking lot by the Football Field, the High School Parking Lot, or in the Payson Recreation Soccer Complex Parking Lot on the East Side of Main Street.)

Please pass this information on to your parents prior to the meet.

We will not be assigning lanes and heats prior to the meet. Students will be called onto the track in groups of girls or boys during the running events. Please condition your students and have them choose which events they would like to participate in. There will not be any advancement from these meets. - Students can participate in: 2 FIELD \& 1 TRACK or 1 FIELD \& 2 TRACK events (Track = any running event; Field = Softball Throw or Standing Long Jump)
- Each school will be allowed 1 Girls and 1 Boys relay team per grade. Relays will only be ran if time permits.
- Payson City Recreation runs Track and Field Day by grade. We will award medals for the top 3 winners in both Boys and Girls events for each grade level. Medals will be sent to the school prior to the end of the year. They can be handed out at each school's end of year assembly.
- Please let your parents know that we will need volunteers to help run some of the events.
