1. New Goal for 2018-19

- Mathematics in place of Science
  - Students in grade 4-6 will show growth on end of year SAGE math assessment
  - Action plan includes:
    - a. Use Utah core standards and CMI information
    - b. Weekly math reteach
    - c. Technicians will run labs and work one on one as well as small groups
    - d. Funded substitutes to provide team opportunities for assessments, design, data review
- Reading Goal
  - Students in grade 1-3 on grade level or making typical progress will improve by 2% over the next year
  - Teachers will improve instruction via staff development, coaching, collaborations and analyzing data
  - Funded substitutes to provide team opportunities for collaboration, data meeting or participate in focused observations.
  - Professional learning opportunities
  - More books purchased for Take Home Library
  - Supplemental reading software
- Fine Arts Goal
  - The number of integrated fine arts lessons K-6 will increase by 32 by the end of the school year.
  - Gains training
  - 6th grade orchestra
  - After school choir for grades 1-6
  - Art and music offered as specialty classes each week
